



NOMAD STONE DATA PROTECTION & PRIVACY POLICY

Nomad Stone Ltd take the protection of your data and your privacy very seriously and know that your privacy is important to you and that you want to know how your data is being used and shared online. We respect and value the privacy of everyone who visits this website, www.nomad-stone.com (“our website”). Below we describe how your personal data is being used in a manner that is consistent with our obligations and your rights under the law. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully and ensure that you understand it. Your acceptance of Our Privacy Policy is deemed to occur upon your first use of our website. If you do not accept and agree with this Privacy Policy, you must stop using our website immediately.

1 – Definitions and Interpretation

In this Policy, the following terms shall have the following meanings: “Cookie” means a small text file placed on your computer or device by our website when you visit certain parts of Our Site and/or when you use certain features of Our Site. Details of the Cookies used by Our Site are set out below; “Cookie Law” means the relevant parts of the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003; “personal data” means any and all data that relates to an identifiable person who can be directly or indirectly identified from that data. In this case, it means personal data that you give to Us via Our Site. This definition shall, where applicable, incorporate the definitions provided in the EU Regulation 2016/679 – the General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”); and “We/Us/Our” means Nomad Stone Ltd.

3 – What Does This Policy Cover?

This Privacy Policy applies only to your use of our website. Our website may contain links to other websites. Please note that we have no control over how your data is collected, stored, or used by other websites and we advise you to check the privacy policies of any such websites before providing any data to them.

4 – Your Rights

4.1 – All site users have rights under GDPR, which the Nomad Stone Ltd Privacy Policy and our use of personal data have been designed to uphold:

4.1.1 – The right to be informed about our collection and use of personal data;

4.1.2 – The right of access to the personal data we hold about you

4.1.3 – The right to rectification if any personal data we hold about you is inaccurate or incomplete by contacting us via hello@nomad-stone.com;

4.1.4 – You may ask Nomad Stone Ltd to delete any personal data held by us, about you;

4.1.5 – The right to restrict (i.e. prevent) the processing of your personal data;

4.1.7 – The right to object to Us using your personal data for particular purposes; and

5 – What Data Do We Collect?

Nomad Stone Ltd may collect some data, depending on the use of our website. Information such as: name; business/company name; job title; profession; demographic information such as town, contact information; country, preferences, IP address; web browser type; operating system; a list of URLs starting with a referring site, your activity on our website.

6 – How Do We Use Your Data

Nomad Stone Ltd use the information we collect to provide you products and services and to conduct other Nomad Stone Ltd business. We use the information for the following:

1. To answer/respond to your enquiries
2. To email and/or post messages with information about Nomad Stone Ltd
3. To telephone you about Nomad Stone Ltd and aspects of our business

Nomad Stone Ltd will only process your data in respect to the continuation of our legitimate interest in line with our business, if we receive your requests related to, a product or service, a call-back, or specific marketing materials; we will use your personal data to fulfil that request by making contact. Nomad Stone Ltd do not sell your personal data to any parties, we only share your personal data within Nomad Stone Ltd as described in this policy, we take your trust very seriously.

In the unusual event that we were approached by a third party, we would look to discuss this with you directly and would seek your direct, written permission before interacting with the third party.

7 - Sharing Information

We wish to make it abundantly clear that Nomad Stone Ltd do not sell your personal data to any parties whatsoever externally. We share your personal data within Nomad Stone Ltd and as described in this policy, we take your trust very seriously. If approached by any third parties, we will always consult with you firstly as to whom and what the nature of their enquiry is and seek any permissions, if applicable.



8 - Retention Period – Personal Data

Nomad Stone Ltd will retain personal data for the required period/duration to complete the transaction specified in this Privacy Policy unless the transaction is extended, or we are obliged to by law.

9 – How and Where Do We Store Your Data?

Data security is very important to Us, and to protect your data We have taken suitable measures to safeguard and secure data collected through Our Site.

10 - Where Is Your Data Shared?

We may sometimes contract with third parties to supply services to you on our behalf. These may include marketing and search engine facilities. In some cases, the third parties may require access to some or all of your data. Where any of your data is required for such a purpose, we will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data will be handled safely, securely, and in accordance with your rights, Our obligations, and the obligations of the third party under the law.

10.1 – Legally we may be required to share data held by us, this may include your personal data. Examples of this would be, where we are involved in legal proceedings, a court order, or a governmental authority.

11 – How Can You Control Your Data?

When you submit personal data via Our Site, you may be given options to restrict Our use of your data. In particular, we aim to give you strong controls on Our use of your data for direct marketing purposes (including the ability to opt-out of receiving emails from Us which you may do by unsubscribing using the links provided in Our emails and at the point of providing your details).

12 – Your Right to Withhold Information

12.1 – You may access certain areas of Our Site without providing any data at all. However, to use all features and functions available on Our Site you may be required to submit or allow for the collection of certain data.

12.2 – You may restrict Our use of Cookies by Accepting or Declining Cookies when you visit our site.



13 – GDPR & Your Data?

Cookie Policy
